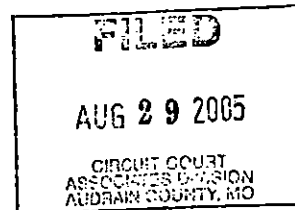

Jason H. Lamb, on his official oath as Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Audrain, State of Missouri, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 569.140, RSMo {charge code 5704007.0}, committed the class B misdemeanor of **TRESPASS FIRST DEGREE**, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.011 and 560.016, by up to six months in the county jail and/or a fine not to exceed \$500.00, in that on or about July 26, 2005, in the County of Audrain, State of Missouri:

WHEREOF, the informant asks the judgment of the Court.



PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT

I, Sgt. Timothy W Roberts #13 Mexico Public Safety Dept. upon my oath, and under penalties of perjury state as follows:

1. I have probable cause to believe that

Dustin L Blue, w/m,
committed one or more criminal offense(s).

Trespassing 1st degree RSMO 569.140

2. The facts supporting this belief are as follows: On 07/26/2005 at 1623 hrs officers were dispatched [redacted] reference to trespassing.

I was then met with the caller, [redacted], who provided me with a written statement stating on 07/26/2005 at approximately 1625 hrs. he observed Dustin Blue leaving the residence [redacted] stated Blue got into a vehicle and left. [redacted] stated he had previous knowledge that Blue had been Banned and Barred from [redacted] ty, so he notified Mexico Public Safety Department.

[redacted] then provided me with a copy of the Ban and Bar letter. I observed PSO Jim Willer #39 served the Ban and Bar Letter on 06/29/2005 at 0825 hrs. I observed the Ban and Bar letter was signed by Dustin Blue.


On 08/03/2005 at 2228 hrs Dustin Blue was read his Miranda Rights from the standard MPSD form. Blue stated he understood his rights and was willing to discuss the offense with out a lawyer present.

Blue then gave a written statement stating that he was at the residence of [redacted]. Blue stated he knew he was not allowed to be at the residence but he needed to get his personal belongings. Blue further added that he has not returned to [redacted] since he got his personal belongings.

3. I believe that defendant poses a danger to the community or to any other person because Blue admittedly went back to the residence knowing he was not allowed to be on the property.
