
INFORMATION

Drew A. Heffner, on his official oath as Assistant Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Audrain, State of Missouri, charges that the defendant, in violation of Section 455.085, RSMo (charge code 2608499.0), committed the class A misdemeanor of **VIOLATION OF ORDER OF PROTECTION**, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.011 and 560.016, RSMo, by up to one year in the county jail and/or a fine not to exceed \$1,000.00, in that on or about July 1, 2005, in the County of Audrain, State of Missouri:

the defendant, having been personally served a copy of an order of the Circuit Court of Audrain County in case number 05AU-PN00108 which prohibited him from communicating with \_\_\_\_\_ in any manner or through any medium, violated it by communicating with \_\_\_\_\_



**PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT**

I **PSO Travis Flatt #36**, with Mexico Public Safety Dept., upon my oath, and under penalties of perjury state as follows:

1. I have probable cause to believe **Dustin L. Blue**, committed one or more criminal offense(s).

**Violation Of A Full Order Of Protection RsMo 455.085**

2. The facts supporting this belief are as follows: On 07-01-05 at 1823 hours, officers were dispatched to \_\_\_\_\_, in reference to a full order of protection violation involving the petitioner, \_\_\_\_\_ and the respondent, Dustin Blue.

Upon my arrival at 1828 hours, I made contact with \_\_\_\_\_ who stated he was at Casey's just a few moments ago and was contacted by Dustin Blue (Respondent), who threatened him.

At this time I obtained a written statement from \_\_\_\_\_ who stated on 07/01/2005 at 1830 hours, he was at Casey's when he turned around to see who was behind him. \_\_\_\_\_ stated Dustin Blue walked up behind him and stated "You have a staring problem, bitch?" \_\_\_\_\_ stated Blue threatened him by stating "I will beat your ass. Don't look at me, pussy bitch." \_\_\_\_\_ stated that Blue continued insulting and threatening him stating "Don't think an order of protection will stop me. I will beat your ass." \_\_\_\_\_ stated he did not say anything to Blue. \_\_\_\_\_ stated he looked at the cashier, later identified as \_\_\_\_\_, and asked her if she heard what he said, and she replied "Yes." \_\_\_\_\_ stated Blue said to the clerk "You didn't hear nothing."

\_\_\_\_\_ girlfriend stated on 07/01/2005 at 1830 hours, Dustin Blue walked up behind \_\_\_\_\_ and her and said "You got a fuckin' starin' problem, bitch? I'll beat your ass. Don't think a protection order is going to scare me don't look at me I'll beat your ass." \_\_\_\_\_ stated Blue was directing these comments to \_\_\_\_\_ stated \_\_\_\_\_ looked at the clerk and asked if she'd heard what Blue said, and Blue then told the clerk "she did not hear a fuckin' thing".

At 1856 hours I made contact with Dustin Blue a \_\_\_\_\_ Blue was placed under arrest for violation of a full order of protection and transported to MPSD. Blue was mirandized at 1913 hours and stated on 07/01/2005 at 1830 hours he was at Casey's General Store pumping gas. Blue stated as he was pumping gas, \_\_\_\_\_ pulled up in a van and sat in the vehicle. Blue stated he (Blue) then went inside to pay for the gas and \_\_\_\_\_ walked in the store, staring at him. Blue stated he told \_\_\_\_\_ to leave him alone, and that \_\_\_\_\_ said that he (Blue) couldn't do anything because of the full order of protection. Blue stated he walked outside to his vehicle and went back home to call the police.

The Full Order Of Protection, which was filed on June 14, 2005 states the respondent, Blue, shall not communicate with the petitioner, \_\_\_\_\_, in any manner or through any medium. The Full Order Of Protection also states the respondent may not attempt to use, or threaten to use physical force against the petitioner.

3. I believe the defendant poses a danger to the crime victim because the defendant verbally threatened the crime victim, violating the full order of protection.

Your request for probation has been approved by the Court. In accordance with the laws of the state of Missouri, you are placed on probation for the period of time stated below. You are hereby advised that the Court may at any time revoke or modify any condition(s) of probation and you shall be subject to arrest upon Order of the Court. At any time within the period of your probation, the Court may order the sentence executed and commit you to confinement as provided by law.

JAIL SENTENCE OF 15 days SUSPENDED EXECUTION OF SENTENCE.

TERM OF PROBATION: 2 YEAR(S).

YOU ARE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS OF PROBATION:

- 1) LAWS: Obey all laws: state, federal, municipal or county ordinances and report any arrest, traffic citation, guilty plea or conviction to the Court.
- 2) RESIDENCY: Report a change of residence within 72 hours to the Court.
- 3) TRAVEL: Do not leave the state of Missouri without receiving advance permission from the Court except \_\_\_\_\_.
- 4) FINES & COSTS: All fines and costs must be paid within 120 days of this probation. TOTAL DUE: 219.00.
- 5) PROBATION BOND: By signing this order, you are stating that you understand that this is an appearance bond in the amount of \$100.00 for which you will be bound to the State of Missouri if you fail to appear as ordered.

YOU ARE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS OF PROBATION IF THEY ARE CHECKED:

- 1)  ALCOHOL: You will not consume any intoxicant of any kind except those prescribed by a doctor. You will not enter any establishment whose primary business is the sale of intoxicants. You will submit to a test of your breath or blood upon request of any law enforcement officer whether or not the officer has probable cause to make such a request.
- 2)  VICTIM'S IMPACT PANEL: You will complete a Victim's Impact Panel and report completion to the Prosecuting Attorney's Office within \_\_\_\_ days.

3) \_\_\_ SATOP PROGRAM: You will successfully complete a SATOP evaluation and program and report completion to the Prosecuting Attorney's Office within \_\_\_ days.

4)  COMMUNITY SERVICE: You will perform 20 hours of community service through the NORTHEAST COMMUNITY SERVICE AGENCY and report completion to the Prosecuting Attorney's Office within 60 days.
