
VIOLATION OF ORDER OF PROTECTION PRIOR OFFENDER

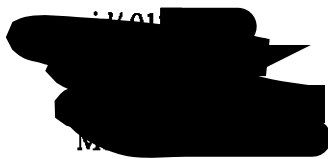

I, PSO P Phelps #35, knowing that false statements on this form are punishable by law, state that the facts contained herein are true.

I have probable cause to believe that Dustin L. Blue; DOB [redacted]; SOC# [redacted]; SID MO01216037; has committed the offense(s) of

VIOLATION OF PROTECTIVE ORDER

The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 07/02/2012 at 1529 hrs officers made contact with [redacted] and she stated that she has a protective order in place against Dustin Blue, protective order filed on 06/13/2012 and served to Blue on 06/14/2012. [redacted] stated that Blue has violated it by attempting to make contact with her; by sending her flowers at her place of employment ([redacted]) and sending her messages through another party [redacted] stated she received flowers on 07/02/2012 at her place of employment from Dustin Blue.

[redacted] stated she was working at Wonneman's Flowers on 07/02/2012 when Dustin Blue came in and purchased flowers for the recipient, K [redacted] W [redacted]. W [redacted] provided [redacted] with photo of Dustin Blue which she confirmed Blue was the one who purchased the flowers.

[redacted] stated that on 06/23/2012 [redacted] sent her a text message saying that Dusty Blue has a ring to put on her finger and he is crazy about her and he still loves her. [redacted] stated that [redacted] was relaying the info to her; because she stated that she promised Dustin Blue she would. [redacted] refused to give statement.

I believe the defendant poses a danger to the community because Blue violated a full order of protection by attempting communications with the protected person by sending her flowers, and attempting to make contact with her through another person by text messaging.
